3.	<p><b>CANADA-JAPAN CO-OP PROGRAM WORK REPORT</b> (i) Inform your supervisor that you have to write a Canada-Japan Co-op Program Experiential Work Term Report and the technical reports requested by your home institution. (ii) Your Canada-Japan Co-op Program Experiential report is a ten page experiential report based on your experiences while in Japan. This report is intended to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Encourage you to reflect on your present Japanese work experience and how it relates to your academic and career development;</li> <li>• Give you an opportunity to reflect on the skills that you are acquiring during your Canada-Japan Co-op Program work term(s) and help you analyze your personal work preferences;</li> <li>• Help you clarify your goals for future Co-op work terms based on your experience in your Canada-Japan Co-op Program work placement;</li> <li>• Assist future Canada-Japan Co-op Program students who are interested in working where you are now; and,</li> <li>• Assist your Canada-Japan Co-op Program Director/staff when conducting the site visit.</li> </ul> <p><b>Your Canada-Japan Co-op Program Experiential Work Report must be:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A minimum of 10 pages, typed.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Inform your supervisor of the report by the second week of your work term.</b></p> <p><b>Please provide your report to your supervisor at least four weeks prior to your end date to allow time for review.</b></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>  <input type="checkbox"/>

	<p>2. Contain a title page, which includes the name, address &amp; web page (if available) of the organization; your name, discipline, school and date of submission.</p> <p>3. Include a discussion on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The nature of the organization employing you; history, where they fit in the industry, products/services;</li> <li>• The nature of the work you are doing;</li> <li>• Your role in the department/organization;</li> <li>• Where your department fits within the organization, its role and responsibilities;</li> <li>• The knowledge and skills you are acquiring;</li> <li>• A reflection on how this Canada-Japan Co-op Program work experience will contribute to both your academic and career development;</li> <li>• A description of the relationships you have with Japanese co-workers and superiors;</li> <li>• A description of your Japanese living arrangements and cultural experiences;</li> <li>• A list of the cultural experiences you had during your duration;</li> <li>• Recommendations you would make to other Canada-Japan Co-op Program students on how to obtain or be successful in the kind of work you are doing; and,</li> <li>• Your overall impression of living in Japan for an extended period and the memories that you will bring back home to Canada.</li> </ul> <p><b>NOTE: Approval must be received by your supervisor if photos taken at the worksite.</b></p> <p>Your supervisor <b>must</b> review your report before it is submitted in order to make sure that it does not contain confidential information.</p> <p>Please note: your experiential report may be displayed on The Canada-Japan Co-op Program website.</p> <p>Unlike a technical report, this report may be written in first person and is based on your impressions and experiences. A Pass (P) or Fail (F) grade will be associated with this report.</p> <p>(iii) Work Term Report: Submit to your supervisor for review.</p> <p>(iv) Work Term Report Release Form: Submit to your supervisor for signature. 6.	<p><b>Work term Fees (\$790.00 per academic term effective May 1, 2020):</b></p> <p>NOTE: students who are registered at UBC as a visiting student during their duration in Japan are required to pay the assessed UBC Co-op tuition fee of \$790.00 per term (effective May 2020) and Student Services fees to be registered at UBC. Work term fees of \$790.00 per term are assessed at the end of the first month of each work term, June, September and January.
