- Have you reviewed the Student Information Presentation on CJCP website?
- Have you reviewed the section of Prospective Students on CJCP website?
- Have you met the following program eligibility/requirements?
 - Are you a co-op student?
 - Is your home institution participating in CJCP?
 - Will you have at least one full-time academic term left to complete after your co-op work term in Japan?
 - Have you completed/will you complete at least one Japanese language course (credit or non-credit) prior to departure?
 - Have you completed/will you complete at least one co-op work term before commencing your co-op work term in Japan?
 - Do you understand that all students who secured a co-op position in the program are required to attend a mandatory CJCP Pre-departure Training Workshop?

If you checked off all boxes, you are eligible to apply to our program. Please complete the Student Application Form.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does “Will you have at least one full-time academic term left to complete after your co-op work term in Japan?” mean?

It means that you cannot graduate prior to, during or right after your co-op work term in Japan due to visa requirements in Japan.

2. What does “Have you completed/will you complete at least one Japanese language course (credit or non-credit) prior to departure?” mean?

In order to be eligible to apply to the Program, students are required to agree to complete at least one Japanese language course prior to departure to their co-op work term in Japan.
